124. SUMMER SCHOOL/CORRESPONDENCE COURSES	
1. Purpose	The Connellsville Area School District recognizes the need to allow students to take district offered summer school courses or correspondence courses on occasion due to unique circumstances.
2. Authority	Guidelines for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.
3. Guidelines	<p>Courses will be offered for make-up work and for credit. The following limitations will apply to make-up courses:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Six (6) total make-up courses grades 9-12. 2. A maximum of three (3) make-up courses in any one (1) summer. 3. No more than two (2) make-up courses can be taken in the same subject area. <p>Correspondence courses will no longer be acceptable except in special situations that are administratively approved.</p> <p>Courses for credit will include Physical Education and Information Processing Applications. Other courses may be added at the discretion of the administration. The following limitations apply to Summer Physical Education and IPA for credit:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Current juniors and seniors may take P.E. and IPA one (1) time each, or P.E. twice (two (2) courses total). 2. Current sophomores and all future classes are limited to one (1) P.E. and one (1) IPA (two (2) courses total).
