SCHOOL DAY ADULT EDUCATION</p> <p>The Board, through the program offerings of the North Fayette Area Vocational Technical School, shall approve and encourage the participation of adult students in school day educational programs. This participation is separate and apart from adult evening classes.</p> <p>Such school day participation shall be in accordance with the following guidelines:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. There shall be no tuition charge to participants who are residents of the Connellsville Area School District. 2. Nonresidents will be charged tuition as determined by administration in accordance with either the Pennsylvania School Code or district costs, contingent upon the nature and duration of the adult participation. 3. All participants must provide legal clearances and background information as required by the district. 4. Participation in any program shall be contingent upon enrollment opening(s) in the requested program and a willingness to accept the adult student by the program instructor. 5. All participants must abide by the policies, rules, regulations, directives, etc. of the district, administration, and program instructor, and must not be a disruption to traditional vocational technical education students. 6. Adult students shall be admitted into programs through an application process established by the administration. 7. Adult students shall enter and exit school day programs and attend during scheduled school hours on dates and at times jointly agreed upon by the student, instructor, and administration.
